### 4. First-aid measures

### 5. Fire-fighting measures

**Suitable extinguishing media:** Water spray, carbon dioxide, dry chemical, or foam.

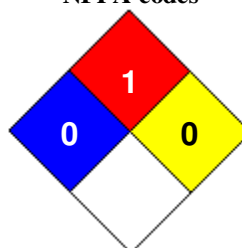
